TMSDC Education Foundation Scholarship Process

TMSDC Education Foundation: The purpose is to provide financial support to at risk high school students to continue their education beyond high school. In addition to the academic profile of the student, particular attention is given to the student's family income. The intended mission of the foundation is to assist students **who demonstrate financial need!!**

Who is TSMSDC?

The TriState Minority Supplier Development Council (TSMSDC) is a non-profit economic development organization which encourages the purchase of goods and services from certified minority businesses. The Council is one of 23 affiliates of the National Minority Supplier Development Council (located in New York, NY). The network includes 1,600 corporations, and 16,000 certified minority businesses. The headquarters of the TriState Council is located in the Metro Center area at 220 Athens Way, Suite 105, Nashville, TN 37228. The TriState Council includes three states- Tennessee, Kentucky and West Virginia.

The Scholarship Application Packet

The complete scholarship packet must include the following:

- -Scholarship Application
- -Scholarship Agreement
- -Answers to the (12) questions. Your answers should be well thought out and concise.
- -Camera ready headshot
- -Autobiography
- -Recommendations from School Counselor and Academic Teacher
- -High School Transcript (ACT or SAT test score)

Order of Packet:

- 1. Cover page (with headshot top right corner)
- 2. Scholarship Application (Signed by student and parent)
- 3. Scholarship Agreement (Signed by student and parent)
- 4. Autobiography
- 5. Questions (Answers to each question are to be on separate pages)
- 6. Counselor Recommendation (MUST be on high school letterhead)
- 7. Teacher Recommendation (MUST be on high school letterhead)
- 8. Student Transcript (with test scores)
- 9. Parental financial information (W-2 form, etc.)

Student Interview: The interview is an opportunity for the panel to get to know candidates better. The panel of judges from various organizations/corporations will interview the scholarship finalists. Candidates chosen will be notified of the interview dates and time. Students are selected on the basis of: <u>Financial need</u>, <u>presentation/content of answers</u>, and the interview.

If chosen to receive a scholarship, funds are sent directly to the student's account at the university for **TUITION** only!!!! (Scholarships are not for books, housing, etc.) The recipient must maintain a 2.5 grade point average to remain eligible to receive funds. **No exception**.

Scholarship Winners will be announced during the Impact Awards Gala (Thursday, May 1st, 2025).

- I. The scholarship funds are to assist with the cost of tuition for post-secondary education only.
- II. You must be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited post-secondary school by fall of 2025 to receive the scholarship funds.
- III. Checks will be written and mailed directly to the <u>school</u>, upon receipt of enrollment notice indicating tuition amount. Checks are <u>not</u> be made payable to students or guardians directly for reimbursement.
- IV. In order to continue to receive scholarship funds, you must be enrolled each consecutive semester as a full-time student. Failure to enroll officially will automatically disqualify you for the remainder of the scholarship balance. This does not include summer enrollment.
- V. Checks will be mailed from the office of the TMSDC Education Foundation. Please allow at least five days for checks to be processed. Questions should be directed to:

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- VI. You must maintain a 2.5 GPA (cumulative) or above to receive scholarship funds. A copy of your grades must be delivered to the TMSDC Education Foundation at the beginning or end of each semester before checks for the following semester will be issued. If you preregister for classes, payment may be due before your grades are issued. Therefore, if you decide to pay for your classes, we cannot reimburse you. All checks will be issued directly to the college or university of your choice.
- VII. If you transfer to another college/university, <u>you</u> are responsible to provide written notification to the TMSDC Education Foundation in advance of any payments. Failure to submit notification will automatically forfeit the remainder of the scholarship balance.
- VIII. It is <u>your</u> responsibility to contact the TMSDC Education Foundation Office at the end and beginning of each semester.
- IX. Only one (1) check for tuition will be written per semester.
- X. When your scholarship funds have been depleted, you will receive a written notice indicating completion of the scholarship award. If you fail to meet the criteria (maintaining a GPA of 2.5 or above and full-time student status) you and your parent or guardian will receive a written notice that the scholarship has been forfeited.
